This policy applies in relation to the sale of alcohol for consumption on and off the premises and is in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 9A of Schedule 3 to the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005

1. It is policy on these premises for Trustees to establish the age of any person attempting to buy alcohol when that person appears to be under the age of 25 years. This policy is a mandatory requirement of the Act.
2. Trustees will require such persons, before being served alcohol, to produce, on request, valid identification. In accordance with the Act, the only valid forms of identification shall be: • A European Union photo-card driving licence • A passport • An approved proof of age photo ID card bearing a PASS (proof of age standards scheme) hologram e.g. Young Scot card
3. The Trustees on the premises shall be alert to the use of false or altered identification and retain the right to decline to serve any person whether or not in possession of valid identification.
4. A refusals book will be maintained and details of any customer who is not served will be noted in the book.
5. The premises licence holder will ensure that all relevant Trustees are made aware of the existence and content of this policy.
6. Full records will be maintained in terms of Trustee training, enforcement of the policy and refusals and those records may be made available for inspection to the police, the licensing authority and its representatives.
